The Council on Social Work Education, CSWE, accredits the **University of Pittsburgh**, MSW program.

The School of Social Work Home & School Visitor/School Social Worker, HSV/SSW, certificate prepares you to work in a Pennsylvania k-12 school.

Since the 1930's, the School of Social Work has offered a DP Home and School Visitor certificate. The program was started by pioneering social work practitioner and educator Marion Hathway.

The DP H&SV/SSW is an inter-professional Educational Specialist certificate, operated jointly with University of Pittsburgh School of Education and by the Pennsylvania Department of Education, intended for students who plan to deliver social work services in elementary or secondary schools. The DP H&SV/SSW certificate program is designed to enhance professional competency in the development

and delivery of high quality social work services to diverse student populations in both public and private elementary and secondary schools.

The certificate program is organized around the Direct Practice specialization and offers students the opportunity to gain advanced knowledge and skills via courses taken in the Schools of Social Work and Education and a field placement in an educational setting.
