Summary:

As a dedicated Licensed Clinical Social Worker, you will provide comprehensive support services to individuals who are blind or have low vision, helping them achieve independence, emotional well-being, and optimal quality of life.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct psychosocial assessments and develop individualized treatment plans for clients with visual impairments
- Provide individual and family counseling services addressing adjustment to vision loss, grief, anxiety, and depression
- Coordinate with vision rehabilitation specialists, occupational therapists, and other healthcare providers
- Assist clients in accessing community resources, benefits, and advocacy services
- Facilitate support groups for clients and family members
- Conduct home visits when necessary to assess living situations and implement interventions
- Maintain detailed clinical documentation and case records
- Participate in multidisciplinary team meetings and care planning
- Provide crisis intervention services as needed
- Develop and implement psychoeducational programs
