Wesley Spectrum has numerous positions available at this time, both entry level or experienced. Wesley Spectrum also provides **FREE** licensure supervision to their employees who are working towards a professional license (LMFT, LPC, LCSW) or certification (BCBA, BCaBA).

## **Behavioral Health Worker – placed within Pittsburgh Public School**

Working on a team consisting of a Mental Health Professional (therapist) and other Behavioral Health Workers, this position will participate in the development and implementation of individualized treatment and behavior support plans, and collaborate with teammates to provide services including trauma informed care, recovery resiliency, PBS, and family therapy. Services will be provided in educational, community, and home settings as indicated by need. The Behavioral Health Worker will also act as a role model to the students served by demonstrating team work, communication and positive interactions with students and staff.

**Education:** Bachelor's degree in Counseling, Psychology, Social Work, or Special Education

**Experience:** Two years working with children and youth in a clinical setting

## **Behavioral Support Staff – Upper St. Clair**

The Behavioral Support Staff provides one-to-one academic and behavioral health interventions to a designated student in order to promote self - management, academic growth, and independent skills in a classroom environment. This position is located in Wesley Spectrum's K-9 School.

**Education:** Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Education or a related field from an accredited institution.

**Experience:** 1 year working with children; in classroom setting preferred

## **Foster Care Coordinator - Wilkinsburg**

Working under the clinical direction of the Program Supervisor, the Foster Care Coordinator performs a wide range of supportive services for children in foster homes and treatment foster homes. Provides support and interventions to the child and birth/foster families. Participates and represents the agency, child, child's birth family, and foster family at permanency planning and team meetings. Develops Individual Service Plans and facilitates achievement of the identified objectives.

**Education:** Bachelor Degree in Social Work, Child Development, Counseling, or related field

**Experience:** Minimum of 1 year in a treatment setting delivering services to special needs children and families

## **Family Therapist openings in the following programs at Greensburg or Wilkinsburg:**

In-Home: Provides intensive home-based family therapy utilizing the structural/strategic model and provides/procures support services for families that are experiencing dysfunction due to abuse, neglect, and behavioral and/or emotional problems.

Family Based Mental Health Services: Provides intensive, family focused, mental health services within homes, schools, and communities to children and their families to prevent out-of-home placements.

**Education:** Bachelor or Master's Degree in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Counseling, or Psychology.

**Experience:** At least 1 year counseling related for BA level and at least 2 years for Masters level

BSC: Designs and directs the implementation of a behavior modification intervention plan which is individualized to each child or adolescent and to family needs.

**License Required:** LSW, LPC, LMFT, or BSL (Behavior Specialist License).

**Education:** Bachelor Degree in Social Work, Child Development, Counseling, Special Education, or related field with no experience required. Can also accept associates or at least 60 credits towards a bachelor's degree with 3 years child related experience.
